DO	4 years to graduate	6 years to graduate

Students are expected to make satisfactory progress toward their degree each term. Students must complete the DO program within six academic years of the matriculation date in the College of Osteopathic Medicine. The IllinoisCOM APPC may grant an additional year in very rare and extenuating circumstances. Students who do not complete their degree in six academic years will not be eligible for additional federal aid without an appeal. Students will need to contact the Office of Financial Aid to determine aid eligibility. The Office of Financial Aid will advise the student of the appeals process for additional aid eligibility to complete their degree if they have met the maximum time frame limit and are allowed to enroll beyond six years.
